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
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### 1. Accessing the modules on different devices



# Can I complete the modules on a tablet or mobile?

### 2. Starting a module



How do I open the module from the overview screen?

The module will open on an overview screen. The overview contains:

- A description
- Approximate duration
- Instructions on how to access support.

Open the module to the **first topic screen** by selecting the **"Start Course"** button.

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
# 3. Using the side menu

- The icon beside each topic title will show you how much of that topic you have completed.




## 4. Navigating through the module

# 5. Completing activities




#### How do I complete activities in the modules?


There are activities throughout the module to help you better understand the modules. Examples include:

- 4. Drag and drop select and drag the item to a category.











#### A multi-agency approach to evacuations

As evacuation is a complex process, careful and pre-emptive planning will enhance community engagement and minimise risks associated with evacuations during emergencies.

Hazard sub plans should outline the risk management strategies and associated evacuation requirements. Any planning for an event or impact should have the capacity to adapt to changing or unforeseen circumstances.

It is a lead agency's responsibility to coordinate the activities of the other organisations and agencies involved.
